 Positive behaviour is recognised and rewarded.
 Consequences are clear.

Behaviour Management in Schools
 Classroom Consequences

Positive Change in behaviour.
 No further Consequence.

Inappropriate Behaviour

Step 1
 Friendly Verbal Warning
 Expected behaviour reinforced.

Inappropriate Behaviour continues

Step 2
 Formal Warning
 Recorded in class
 Tracking Book by student.

Inappropriate Behaviour continues

Step 3
 In class Time Out
 Recorded in Class Tracking Book by teacher.
 A restorative conversation with the teacher takes place upon student's return to class.

Inappropriate Behaviour continues

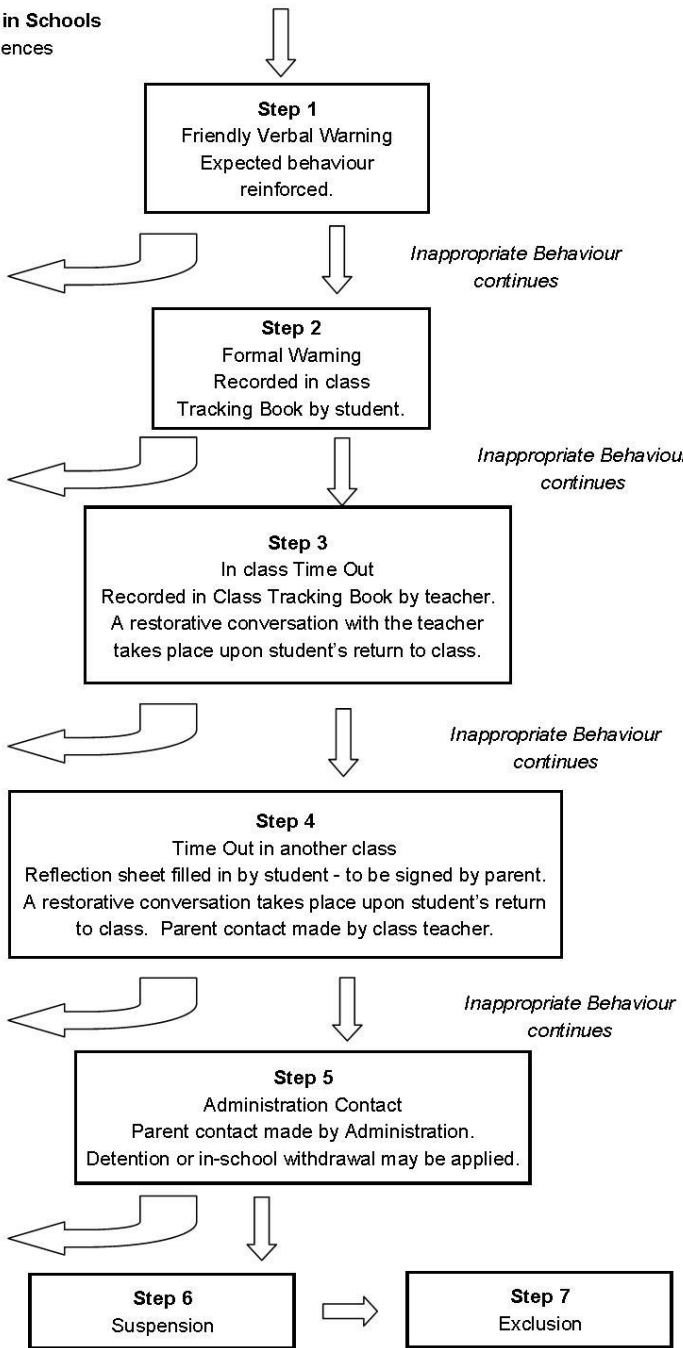
Step 4
 Time Out in another class
 Reflection sheet filled in by student - to be signed by parent.
 A restorative conversation takes place upon student's return to class. Parent contact made by class teacher.

Inappropriate Behaviour continues

Step 5
 Administration Contact
 Parent contact made by Administration.
 Detention or in-school withdrawal may be applied.

Step 6
 Suspension

 Exclusion





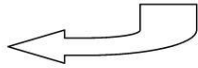
Behaviour Management in Schools
Playground Consequences

POSITIVE PLAYGROUND ENVIRONMENT
 Students are aware of expectations.
 Students are encouraged to play together.
 Duty teachers are easily identifiable.
 Faction tokens are given for positive playground behaviour.

Inappropriate Behaviour

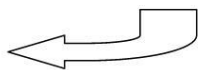


Step 1—Minor Incident
 Duty Teacher resolves conflict through discussion.
 Student/s return to playground.



Inappropriate Behaviour continues

Step 2—Moderate Incident
 As per Step 1. Five minute Time Out—student to walk with Duty Teacher.
 A restorative conversation takes place upon returning to the playground.



Inappropriate Behaviour continues

Step 3—Major/Moderate Incident
 As per Step 2. Student is asked to 'shadow' Duty Teacher.
 (May be appropriate for students who do not respond to Step 2.)
 Green Slip filled out and behaviour recorded in SIS by Admin.



Inappropriate Behaviour continues

Step 4—Major Incident
 (eg fighting, bullying)
 Student is removed from playground for the rest of the break.
 Fast tracked to Admin with a Green Slip.
 Student may be issued a detention and removed from the playground for a nominated time.
 Parent contact made by Admin and behaviour recorded in SIS.

Positive Change in behaviour.
No further Consequence.
